Contributors include the leader of the Scottish Liberal Democrats (Willie Rennie MSP) who writes about his experience as a candidate in the Dunfermline and West Fife by-election. Rory Tinman writes about the Fermanagh and South Tyrone by-election in 1981 which is based on recent interviews with participants on the Irish Republican side of the debate. The election was won by H-block prisoner Bobby Sands who died just a few weeks after the election whilst on hunger strike. Other contributors include Daniel Burrill (Lincoln, 1973), Ryan Davies (Newport, 1922), Miles Fowler (Carmarthen, 1966), Ben Manley (Mitcham and Morden, 1982), Camelia Manzoori (Plymouth Sutton, 1919), Iain Miller (Northern Ireland, 1986) and Tom Wowk (Kilmarnock, 1933). As the book focuses on twentieth century by-elections there are a number of examples of seats which were significant in the progress of Irish, Welsh and Scottish nationalism.
